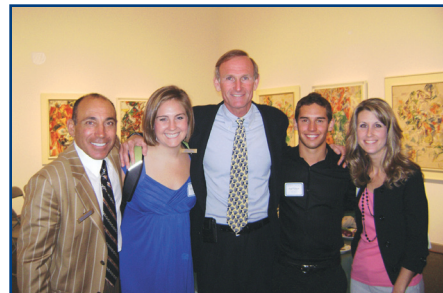

STUDENTS SPEAK ABOUT PROJECT SERVE WEEK AT CREST ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

The purpose of Pepperdine's Crest Advisory Board is to further the relationship between Malibu, the University, and the surrounding communities, as well as mentor and encourage students in their endeavors. During the March Crest Advisory Board meeting held in the Frederick R. Weisman Museum at the Malibu campus, Seaver students Paul Volcheff and Madison Krall spoke about their recent experience with the annual Project Serve week. Senior Paul Volcheff led a team of 15 students in the Nicaraguan refugee town of La Carpio in Costa Rica, and Madison spoke of her work in Chicago, Illinois, with the DOOR Network, and saw firsthand the social needs of an urban city. In all, over 200 Pepperdine students spent their Spring Break assisting communities around the world in building homes, mentoring children, providing medical care, and fostering faith. Fifteen groups of students traveled to various corners of the world, including Fiji, Guatemala, the Dominican Republic, and Panama, as well as a number of locations within the United States such as Chicago; Waco, Texas; and the San Carlos Apache Reservation in Arizona putting into action Pepperdine's strong commitment to serving those in need.
