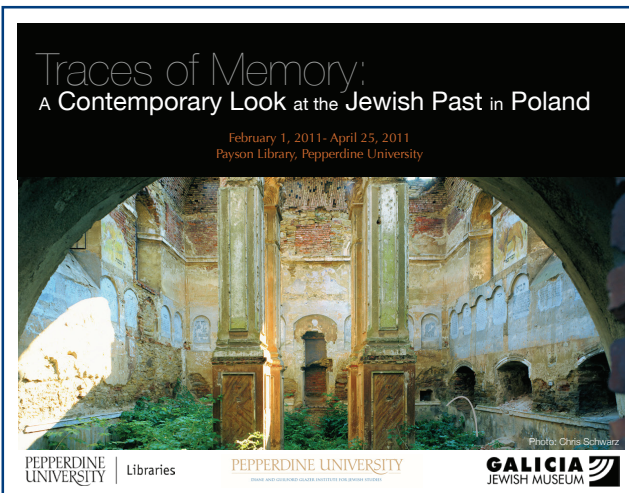
FOCUS ON SERVICE – PEPPERDINE STUDENTS FORM “HAITI SOLIDARITY TEAM”
