## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Lectureship Central is located in the upstairs lobby of Tyler Campus Center. This will be the main point of contact. For information and registration, please check here. The telephone number is (213) 456-4270 or Extension 270. For information before Lectureship, write Lectureship Office, Pepperdine University, Malibu, CA 90265. Lectureship Central will be open the following hours:

1:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Sunday

7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

Housing is available in the dormitory suites beginning at noon on Sunday, April 15, until 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 19. Please make reservations as early as possible on the attached form or contact Special Programs, Pepperdine University, Malibu, CA 90265, (213) 456-4264. You will be told your housing assignment at the Housing Reception Center.

There is no charge for your housing unless you need to rent linens at the nominal fee of \$4.00. If you are driving, you may wish to bring your own—sheets (extra long twins), pillows, blankets, towels, etc. Children sleeping in the same room as their parents will need sleeping bags. Clothes hangers and soap are not provided.

Camper-Trailer Space is available in an upper parking lot overlooking the campus and the ocean. Water is available and the space is well lighted. Call or write for this free space.

Motels-Hotels Upon request, a list of motels and hotels in the area will be sent to you.

Meals will be served in Tyler Dining Room beginning with breakfast on Monday and ending with dinner on Wednesday. There will be no variation of menus for special meetings, and all guests will purchase tickets at the door for each meal, go through the line and proceed to the general dining area or specially designated areas for specific meetings.

Hours are 1:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Sunday and 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.

Transportation Van service is available from the main campus to Firestone Fieldhouse beginning 15 minutes before and 15 minutes after the lectures. You may also get transportation to and from your dorm throughout the day. Loading and unloading will be from Jerry's Tree, Firestone Fieldhouse and dormitories. For special transportation needs, call Lectureship Central (Ext. 270). Contact the Lectureship office for transportation to and from the airport.

Parking Information and Regulations Please heed the following suggestions:

- The main parking lot is reserved for construction workers and staff. You may park anywhere along Seaver Drive or Grand Boulevard. Vans will be making regular runs to prevent your having to walk long distances.
- Always lock your car.
- Observe posted campus parking regulations.
- Mobile homes and/or campers are to park in the UPPER
- Do not park in fire lane by dormitories. You will be allowed to load and unload next to the dormitories, and then you MUST move your car.

Regulations are enforced by Campus Security and the Malibu Fire Marshall. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Child Care will be provided in Dorm 1 and in Firestone Fieldhouse, rooms 122, 123, 124, with a planned program of supervised activities. A cost of \$1.00 per day will help defray expenses (payable at the Child Care facility).

Child Care will be provided at Firestone Fieldhouse only during the hours of the main lectures. NOTE: In addition, child care will be provided Tuesday through the Dinner hour, 1:45 p.m. - 9:00 p.m., continuously.

THE W.W. PACE AWARD

Brother Pace, an early California preacher, arrived from Texas in 1918. In 1965, Pepperdine University awarded him the Christian Service Award. At the time of his death, brother Pace was completing his 50th year of full-time ministry. It is in honor of this ministry that in 1973 Pepperdine established the W.W. Pace Ministerial Award.
