Message from Mike Cope



“In her voyage across the ocean of this world, the Church is like a great ship being pounded by the waves of life’s different stresses. Our duty is not to abandon ship but to keep her on her course.” Those pastoral words from Boniface, an eighth-century English Benedictine monk, still ring true.

It’s why the Hebrews writer insisted that we need an anchor in the midst of stormy seas: our hope, which is “firm and secure” (6:19).

The writer also describes those of us in need of this anchor as people “who have fled for refuge to take hold of the hope set before us” (6:18).

That’s why a decade ago we took the name “Harbor.” Set here on the edge of the Pacific Ocean, we want our gathering to be a sacred place where God infuses his hope and joy again through friendships, worship, messages, meals, and the beauty of God’s creation.

So welcome, friends. Thank you so much for coming. This theme has been selected because with so many challenges around us we are in need of running with perseverance. We need fresh engagement with scripture, with the people of God, and—mostly importantly!—with the risen Christ who “lives to intercede” for us (7:25).

May you find deep renewal and refreshment this week. May you “flee for refuge” to the one who can sustain you!

RECREATION AND LEISURE

ALUMNI PARK

Location: Bottom of the hill. Alumni Park is a great place to relax, toss a ball or Frisbee, or watch the ducks at the pond.

THOMAS E. BURNETT, JR. HEROES GARDEN

Location: Top of the Drescher Graduate Campus. This beautiful outdoor chapel serves as a place of reflection and remembrance.

HIKE TO THE CROSS

A self-guided, one-mile hiking trail begins at the top of Baxter Drive. With a climb of 830 feet within a half mile, it is considered a moderate to difficult hike. The trail closes at dusk. Remember to carry water with you.

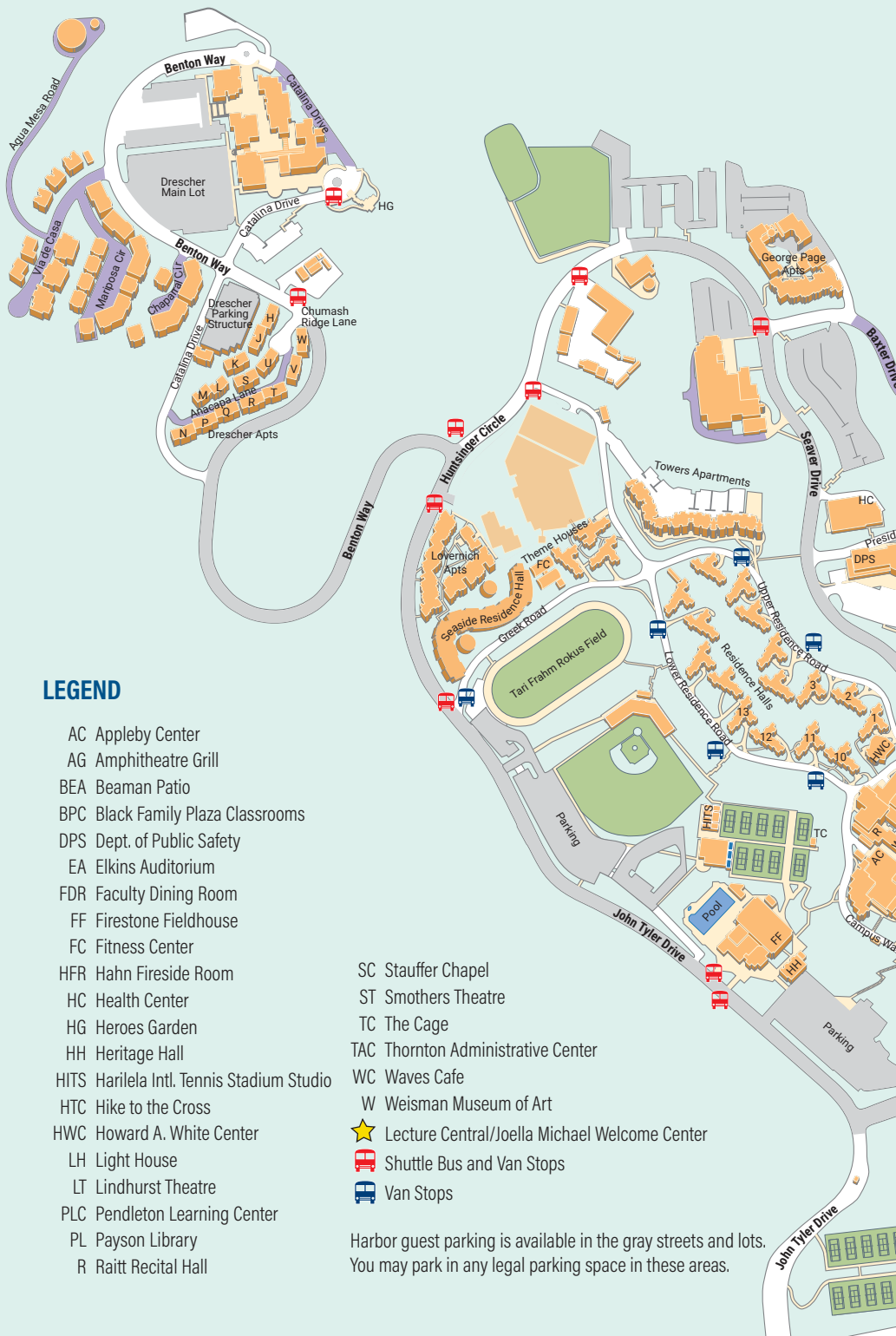

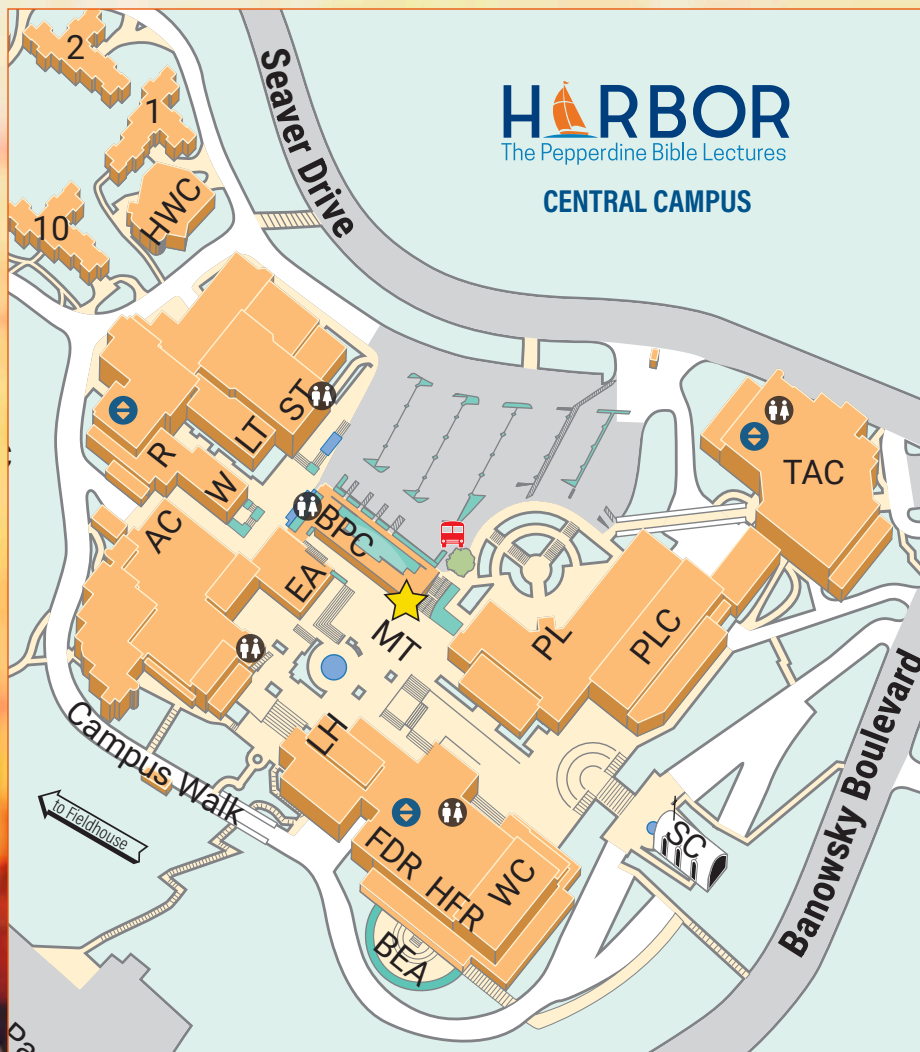
