 1 *"How often should I forgive?"* (18.21)
 2 *"Seventy times seven."* (18.22)

8 ~ *Lead us not into temptation*

- N **... and lead us not into temptation ...**
 1 *"Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.*
 2 *The tempter came and said to him, 'Command that these stones become loaves of bread.'*
 1 *But he answered, 'A person does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'*
 2 *'Throw yourself down.'*
 1 *'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'*
 2 *'Fall down and worship me.'*
 1 *'Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him.'"* (4.1-11)

9 ~ *Deliver us from evil*

- N **... but deliver us from evil ...**
 1 *"First be reconciled to your brother or sister."* (5.24)
 2 *"If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away."* (5.29)
 1 *"Let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No' be 'No.'*
 Any more than this leads to evil." (5.37)
 2 *"Do not resist an evildoer."*
 1 *"Turn the other cheek."*
 2 *"Give your cloak as well."*
 1 *"Give and do not refuse."* (5.38-42)
 2 *"Love your enemies."* (5.44)
 N **... but deliver us from evil ...**
 1, 2 *"Enter through the narrow gate;*
 1 *for the gate is wide and the road is easy that leads to destruction,*
 2 *and there are many who take it.*
 1 *For the gate is narrow and the road is hard that leads to life,*
 2 *and there are few who find it."* (7.13-14)

10 ~ *For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever*

- N **... for thine is the kingdom ...**
 1 *"Your kingdom come."* (6.10)
 ... and the power ...
 2 *"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me."* (28.18)
 ... and the glory ...
 1, 2 *"Give glory to your Father in heaven."* (5.16)
 N, 1, 2 **For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever,**
 N **Amen.**
