

Although 1 John defies conventional organization, a number of theological threads run throughout the letter. This reading, adapted from the New Revised Standard Version, arranges the material in 1 John topically to highlight those theological threads. It is configured here for a Leader (litanist, lector) (L) and two readers.

MESSAGE ONE ~ GOD

- L This is the message we have heard...
- 1 God is light,
- 2 and in him is no darkness at all.
- 1 God is greater than our hearts,
- 2 and God knows everything.
- The one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.
- 2 God is love.
- God abides in those who confess that Jesus is the Son of God.
- 2 God is love.
- All God gave us eternal life.

Message Two ~ Jesus Christ

- L This is the message we have heard...
- God sent his only Son into the world so that we might live through him.
- 2 The Father sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.
- All Jesus Christ has come in the flesh.
- 1 He was revealed to take away sins, in him there is no sin.
- 2 The Son of God was revealed to destroy the works of the devil.
- 1 The blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
- 2 He will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 We have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
- 2 He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins.
- All He laid down his life for us.

MESSAGE THREE ~ WE

L This is the message we have heard...

All We are from God.

- 1 We are God's children.
- We have been anointed by the Holy One, and we all have knowledge.
- 1 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is true.
- 2 We have boldness before God.
- 1 We receive from him whatever we ask,

because we obey his commandments and do what pleases him.

- 2 We love because he first loved us.
- 1 We are God's children now;
- 2 and what we will be has not yet been revealed.
- L What we do know is this,
- 1 that when he is revealed,
- All we will be like him,
- 2 for we will see him just as he is.

MESSAGE FOUR ~ IF WE

- L This is the message we have heard...
- If we say that we have fellowship with him while walking in darkness,
- 2 we lie and do not do what is true.
- 1 If we walk in the light as he himself is in the light,
- 2 we have fellowship with one another.
- 1 If we say that we have no sin,
- 2 we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 1 If we confess our sins,
- 2 he will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 If we say that we have not sinned,
- 2 we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
- 1 If we do sin,
- 2 we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous,
- 1 If we obey his commandments,
- 2 we may be sure that we know God.
- 1 If what you heard from the beginning abides in you,
- 2 then you will abide in the Son and in the Father.
- 1 If you know that he is righteous,
- 2 you may be sure that everyone who does right is born of him.
- 1 If anyone says, I love God, and hates their brothers or sister,
- 2 they are liars.
- 1 If we ask anything according to his will,
- 2 he hears us.

Message Five ~ Whoever

- L This is the message we have heard...
- L Whoever..
- 1 ...says, I know him, but does not obey his commandments,
- 2 is a liar.
- L Whoever...
- ...obeys God's word,
- 2 the love of God has reached maturity in this person.
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...says, I abide him,
- 2 ought to walk just as Jesus walked.
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...says, I am in the light, while hating a brother or sister,
- 2 is still in the darkness.
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...loves a brother or sister
- 2 lives in the light....
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...hates a brother or sister
- *is in the darkness, and walks in the darkness, and does not know the way.*
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...does not love
- 2 abides in death.
- L Whoever...
- 1 ...has the Son
- 2 has life.

MESSAGE SIX ~ EVERYONE

- *L* This is the message we have heard...
- 1 Everyone who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness.
- 2 Everyone who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous.
- 1 Everyone who commits sin is a child of the devil.
- 2 Everyone who has been born of God does not sin,

because God's seed abides in them.

- 1 Everyone who obeys God's commandments abides in God, and God abides in him.
- 2 Everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
- 1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God,
- 2 and everyone who loves the parent loves the child.

MANDATE ONE ~ LOVING THE WORLD

- L This is the message we have heard...

 And this is the commandment...
- Do not love the world or the things in the world.
 - Do not love the world:
- *The love of the Father is not in those who love the world.*
- 1 Do not love the things of the world:
- 2 For all that is in the world—the desire of the flesh, the desire of the eyes, pride in riches—comes not from the Father but from the world.
- 1 Do not love the world or the things in the world.
- 2 For the world and its desire are passing away,
- All but those who do the will of God live forever.

MANDATE Two ~ ABIDING IN HIM

- L And this is the commandment...
- 1 Abide in him,
- 2 so that when he is revealed we may have confidence and not be put to shame before him at his coming.

MANDATE THREE ~ BEHOLDING THE LOVE

- L And this is the commandment...
- 1 See what love the Father has given us,
- 2 that we should be called the children of God, and we are!

MANDATE FOUR ~ LOVING ONE ANOTHER

- L And this is the commandment...
- 1 Love one another.
- 2 Because we love one another, we have passed from death to life.
- 1 And we ought to lay down our lives for one another.
- All Love one another.
- 2 For love is from God.
- 1 Since God loved us so much,
- 2 we also ought to love one another.
- L And this is the commandment...
- 1 We should believe in the name of God's son, Jesus Christ.
- Who conquers the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 1 Those who love God
- 2 must love their brothers and sisters as well.
- 1 Let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action.
